PROOF OF THE DEITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST

As Given in this Gospel By Fred John Meldau

"In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. . . . All things were made by him" (1:1, 3).

Here is the proof of Christ's Deity:

(1) He existed eternally before coming to our world (1:1;

17:5).

(2) He is definitely called God (1:1; 20:28). Many times He is called the Son of God, a name that signifies Deity, equality with the Father (5:19-29).

(3) He is the Creator of the universe (1:1-3).

(4) He possesses the real life, the eternal Being of God,

"life in himself" (1:4; 5:26).

(5) He came into the world to be the Saviour of mankind—a work only God could do. His death atoned for the sin of the race (1:29).

(6) He has all the powers and characteristics of God. He is all-powerful (5:19). His miracles were a demonstration of His power (see 14:10, 11). He is all-knowing (1:48; 4:29; 5:20;

13:19; 16:30). He is omnipresent (3:13).

(7) He holds the offices of God and does the work of God. He is to be believed in, even as the Father is (14:1). He saves the souls of men and forgives sins (3:18; 5:24; 8:11). Only God can forgive sins (Mark 2:7). He receives human worship (9:38). Worship is for God only. Christ is to be honored, worshipped, the same as the Father (5:23). He will resurrect all men, both the saved and the lost, and He will be the final Judge of all mankind (5:28, 29; 5:22, 27).

(8) He has the character of God, being sinless and perfect in being (8:46; 5:19; 19:4), and perfect in love (13:1; 15:12; see I John 4:8). He is perfectly loved by the Father—showing His

perfection (15:10; 17:24).

(9) The final proof and sign of the Deity of Christ is His resurrection from the dead. See notes on 2:19; 20:1, 8, 16, 24.
