It's as easy as eating and drinking (John 6:35). It's as easy as going through a door (John 10:9) or opening a door (Rev. 3:20). It's as easy as looking (John 3:14-15; Isa. 45:22). On the other hand, there are reasons why salvation can be very difficult:

★ 1) Depraved people find it very difficult to humble themselves and acknowledge their utter sinfulness and spiritual bankruptcy (Luke 18:9-14).

2) Proud men believe they must do something to earn their salvation, and they have difficulty believing it is all of grace and all of God (Eph. 2:8-9).

**★** 3) Lost men love their sins and do not want to come to the light (John 3:18-20).

★ 4) Christ taught that it was extremely difficult, yea, impossible, for a rich man to be saved, due to the fact that no one can be saved while trusting anything or anyone other than Christ (Matt. 19:23-26). But all of these difficulties can be overcome because the gospel is "the power of God unto salvation to all who believe" (Rom. 1:16). God is able!
