

The Crucifixion Psalm

Seven Amazing Predictions

Psalm 22:1-18

Written a thousand years before Christ was executed and long before Roman crucifixion even existed,

Psalm 22 contains at least seven specific prophecies which were literally fulfilled when the Saviour died on the cross:

1) It was predicted that Christ would be separated and forsaken by God because of God's holiness: "My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?....But Thou art holy" (*Psalm 22:1,3; Matt. 27:46*). These are the exact words which the Saviour spoke from the cross with a loud voice. He who was made to be sin for us took our place and suffered for our sins, the righteous One, for the unrighteous ones (*1 Pet. 3:18*).

2) It was predicted that Christ would be ridiculed and mocked. Notice the similarity in the language between the prediction and the fulfillment: "...saying, He trusted on the Lord that He would deliver Him: let Him deliver Him, seeing He delighted in Him" (*Psalm 22:7-8*). "Likewise also the chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said....He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now, if He will have Him (*Matt. 27:41,43*).

3) It was predicted that Christ's physical sufferings would be excruciating, involving exhaustion, bone dislocation, violent disorder of internal organs and severe weakness (*Psalm 22:14*).


4) It was predicted that Christ would suffer unremitting thirst (*Psalm 22:15; John 19:28*).

5) It was predicted that Christ's hands and feet would be pierced (*Psalm 22:16; John 20:27*).

6) It was predicted that Christ would be in a state of at least partial nakedness with His bones pressing out against His skin (*Psalm 22:17*).

7) It was predicted that people would divide His garments and gamble for His coat. Certainly the Roman soldiers who did this had no idea that they were fulfilling an ancient Hebrew prophecy (*Psalm 22:18; John 19:23,24*). **Hallelujah, what a Saviour!**
