



Thoughts to Ponder Regarding Sin

Romans 7:14-25

Consider these proverbs relating to sin:

- ☛ Sin is the greatest of detectives (Numbers 32:23).
- ☛ The deadliest sins do not leap upon us; they creep upon us.
- ☛ The test of a person's character is what he does when no one is watching (Phil. 2:12).
- ☛ A hypocrite is a fellow who isn't himself on Sunday.
- ☛ The only exercise some people get is jumping to conclusions, sidestepping responsibilities, dodging issues, passing the buck, and pressing their luck!
- ☛ He that thinks little of sin has never thought much of God, nor of the cross.
- ☛ Collapse in the Christian life is rarely a blowout; it's usually a slow leak.
- ☛ What if you woke up today with only the things that you thanked God for yesterday?
- ☛ SIN=Self Inflicted Nonsense.
- ☛ The unsaved person lives in sin and **loves it**; the born-again person at times lapses into sin and **loathes it**.
- ☛ No matter how long you nurse a grudge, it won't get better.
- ☛ Don't grumble because you don't have what you want; **be thankful you don't get what you deserve**.
- ☛ "Desire in a creature for ought else but God's glory is sin" (W. R. Newell).
- ☛ Sin will take you further than you ever thought you'd stray; sin will keep you longer than you ever thought you'd stay; sin will cost you more than you'd ever thought you'd pay.
- ☛ "The Bible will keep you from sin or sin will keep you from the Bible" (Moody).
- ☛ Let us suffer the greatest sorrow rather than commit the least sin!
- ☛ There is no right way to do a wrong thing.
- ☛ Whatever you dislike in another person, be sure to correct in yourself.
- ☛ What you love and what you hate reveals the kind of person you are.
- ☛ May every day be **a day of reckoning** (see Romans 6:1-13).
- ☛ God formed us; sin deformed us; but **Christ alone can transform us**.

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
